





AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY
GANA O, MUNICIPALITY OF DUPAX DEL SUR, PROVINCE OF
NUEVA VIZCAYA TO BE KNOWN AS GANA O NATIONAL HIGH
SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Establishment of a National High School.* – There is
2 hereby established, under the supervision of the Department of Education, a
3 national high school in Barangay Ganao, Municipality of Dupax del Sur,
4 Province of Nueva Vizcaya to be known as Ganao National High School.

5 SEC. 2. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall
6 immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of
7 Ganao National High School, the funding of which shall be included in the
8 annual General Appropriations Act.

9 SEC. 3. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue such
10 rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

11 SEC. 4. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
12 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
