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# Explanatory Note

As the school year begins, it is a time when parents, families, teachers, school administrators, and communities increase their focus on children and youth throughout the Philippines. Hence, raising awareness of and increasing support for organizations that provide access to social services, education, the arts, sports, and other services that will result in the development of character and the future success of Filipino children and youth must be attained.

Designating June of every year as "National Child Awareness Month" would recognize that a long-term commitment to children and youth is in the public interest, and will encourage widespread support for charities and organizations that seek to provide a better future for the children and youth of the Philippines.

Thus, this bill aims to (1) to promote awareness of charities benefitting children and youthserving organizations throughout the Philippines; and (2) to recognize efforts made by such charities and organizations on behalf of children and youth as a positive investment in the future of the Philippines.

In view of the foregoing, the early passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

### AN ACT

# **DESIGNATING JUNE OF EVERY YEAR AS THE 'NATIONAL CHILD AWARENESS MONTH' TO PROMOTE AWARENESS OF CHARITIES BENEFITTING CHILDREN** AND YOUTH-SERVING ORGANIZATIONS THROUGHOUT THE PHILIPPINES AND **RECOGNIZING EFFORTS MADE BY THESE CHARITIES AND ORGANIZATIONS** ON BEHALF OF CHILDREN AND YOUTH AS A POSITIVE INVESTMENT IN THE FUTURE OF THE PHILIPPINES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

#### 1 SECTION 1. Short Title .- This Act shall be known as the "National Child Awareness Month of 2008."

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SEC. 2. Declaration of Policy. It is the policy of the State to recognize the vital role of

5 the children in nation building, promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual

6 and social being.

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8 SEC. 3. Child Awareness Month. To promote awareness of charities benefitting children and youth-serving organizations throughout the Philippines and to recognize efforts made by 9 such charities and organizations on behalf of children and youth as a positive investment in the 10 11 future of the Philippines, the whole month of June of every year shall be declared as the National 12 Child Awareness Month.

| 12 | SEC. 6. Repealing Clause. Any laws, decrees, ordinances or rules and regulations which             |
| 13 | are inconsistent with or contrary to the provision of this Act is hereby amended or repealed.      |

| 15 | SEC. 7. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete               |
| 16 | publication in at least two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.                        |
