**A RESOLUTION  
EXPRESSING THE CONCERN OF THE SENATE THAT THE PHILIPPINES  
RANKED FIFTH IN THE GLOBAL SURVEY ON HUNGER**

*Whereas*, the Philippines landed on the fifth place in the global survey on hunger conducted by Gallup International;

*Whereas*, Gallup International is a Zurich-based international group with almost 60 members and research capabilities in almost 100 countries around the world;

*Whereas*, Gallup International questioned more than 58,000 people coming from 55 countries in June to September for the World Food Survey;

*Whereas*, four in ten Filipinos or 40 percent said they "often or sometimes" lacked food in the past year;

*Whereas*, the outcome of the survey is consistent with a similar survey conducted by the Social Weather Stations (SWS) late September this year;

*Whereas*, the SWS survey revealed that 3.3M Filipino families were suffering from hunger in the last three quarters;

*Whereas*, there may be a need for legislation to provide government policy capable to immediately address the problem of hunger among our countrymen.

*Be it resolved*, as it is hereby resolved, to express the concern of the Senate that the Philippines ranked fifth in the global survey on hunger.
