- AN ACT APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF EIGHT BILLION PESOS (P8,000,000,000.00) AS SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF RELIEF OPERATIONS, RECONSTRUCTION AND REHABILITATION OF THE PROVINCES OF ILOILO, AKLAN, CAPIZ, ANTIQUE AND ILOILO CITY, ALL IN THE ISLAND OF PANAY; BACOLOD CITY, AND THE PROVINCES OF NEGROS OCCIDENTAL AND GUIMARAS WHICH SUFFERED DEVASTATION BROUGHT ABOUT BY TYPHOON FRANK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. Appropriations. – The sum of Eight billion pesos 2 (P8,000,000,000.00) is appropriated for the implementation of relief 3 operations, reconstruction and rehabilitation of the Provinces of Iloilo, 4 Antique, Aklan, Capiz, Guimaras, Negros Occidental, Iloilo City and Bacolod 5 City. The sum appropriated shall be called the "Paglaum Fund" or the "Fund".

SEC. 2. Guidelines in the Allocation of the Paglaum Fund. - The 1 Paglaum Fund herein appropriated shall be spent judiciously in consonance 2 with the principle of providing the greatest good for the greatest number. 3 4 The following guidelines shall be observed in allocating the Paglaum Fund:

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(a) Priority shall be given to the construction, repair and/or reconstruction of roads and bridges, communication and power lines, hospitals, 6 7 school buildings, water and irrigation systems and such other projects as drainage works, resettlement centers and homesites; 8

9 (b) Aid, relief, rehabilitation and livelihood shall be extended equitably to all victims, irrespective of political or party affiliations, gender, creed, 10 religious belief, or ethnic origin, giving emphasis to livelihood and 11 12 employment opportunities; and

(c) No money shall be released without any identified program or 13 project nor shall any sum from the Paglaum Fund be used to pay obligations 14 incurred before the approval of this Act. 15

SEC. 3. Use of the Paglaum Fund. - The Paglaum Fund shall be used 16 to cover the repair, rehabilitation and construction of roads, bridges, irrigation 17 systems, school buildings, government buildings, sea ports and airports, Ì8 hospitals and other public infrastructures; purchases of hospital equipment, 19 supplies and medicines; purchases of relocation sites; construction of housing 20 units; and funding for the Comprehensive Integrated Delivery of Social 21 Services (CIDSS) under the Department of Social Welfare and Development, 22 livelihood programs, agricultural assistance and other support programs for 23 24 farmers and fisherfolk.

The Paglaum Fund shall be used for the purposes indicated and shall be 25 released to the relevant departments, bureaus, offices, agencies and local 26 27 government units (LGUs) in accordance with budgeting and related relevant 28 laws, rules and regulations.

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SEC. 4. Creation of the Western Visayas (Region VI) Rehabilitation 1 2 and Development Commission. - For purposes of this Act, the Western Visayas (Region VI) Rehabilitation and Development Commission, hereinafter 3 referred to as the Commission, is hereby created. The Commission shall be 4 5 organized within thirty (30) days after the approval of this Act and shall exist 6 for a term of two (2) years after its organization. Such amount as may be 7 necessary for the organization and operations of the Commission shall be set 8 aside from the amount herein appropriated. SEC. 5. Composition of the Commission. - The Commission shall be 9 10 composed of the following: 11 Chairman: (a) The Chairman of the National Disaster Coordinating Council 12 13 (NDCC). 14 Members: (a) The Chairman of the Regional Development Council of Region VI; 15 16 (b) The Cabinet Officer for Regional Development; 17 (c) The Secretary of Agriculture; 18 (d) The Secretary of Budget and Management; 19 (e) The Secretary of Social Welfare and Development; (f) The Secretary of Education; 20 21 (g) The Secretary of Health: 22 (h) The Secretary of Public Works and Highways; (i) The Administrator of the National Electrification Administration; 23 The General Manager of the National Housing Authority; and 24 (i) – (k) The Presidential Assistant for Western Visayas. 25 Ľ j

SEC. 6. Powers and Functions of the Commission. - The Commission 1 2 shall have the following powers:

(a) Formulate policies and plans for relief operations, reconstruction, 3 4 rehabilitation, and construction of public infrastructures, livelihood and other social support services in harmony with plans and policies of the national 5 6 government;

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(b) Prioritize and coordinate the implementation of the various programs and projects of the Commission; 8

9 (c) Coordinate and consult with concerned national and local officials 10 as well as accredited nongovernment organizations (NGOs) in the 11 determination of priorities and the implementation of the programs and projects of the Commission: 12

(d) Call upon any department, office, instrumentality, agency or 13 political subdivision of the government for such assistance as may be needed; 14 ς. 15 and

(e) Perform such powers and functions as may be necessary and proper 16 to carry out the purpose of this Act. 17

SEC. 7. Secretariat of the Commission. - The regional development 18 council of Region VI shall serve as the secretariat of the Commission and shall 19 assist the Commission in carrying out its functions. For purposes of this Act, 20 the Presidential Assistant for Western Visayas shall be the Executive Director 21 22 of the secretariat.

SEC. 8. Joint Congressional Oversight Committee. - There is hereby 23 created a Joint Congressional Oversight Committee to monitor the 24 25 implementation of this Act for a period not exceeding two (2) years from the actual release of the Fund. The Committee shall be composed of five (5) 26 27 senators and five (5) representatives to be appointed by the Senate President and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The Committee shall be 28

co-chaired by a senator and a representative designated by the Senate President
 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, respectively.

3 SEC. 9. *Rules and Regulations.* – The Department of Budget and 4 Management shall issue the necessary implementing rules and regulations to 5 effectively carry out the provisions of this Act.

6 SEC. 10. Submission of Report to Congress. – The Commission shall 7 submit to the President and to Congress, through the Chairman of the 8 Committee on Appropriations, in the case of the House of Representatives, and 9 the Committee on Finance, in the case of the Senate, a detailed quarterly report 10 on the funds allocated indicating the amount released, obligated and disbursed 11 for:

(a) Aid, relief, reconstruction, rehabilitation, social support and
livelihood services, including the list of names of approved individual
beneficiaries, contractors and other service providers, and the evaluation of the
effectiveness of the delivery systems of such services; and

(b) Construction, repair and/or reconstruction of infrastructure projects,
including the list of contractors and projects being financed, and the
accomplishments thereof.

SEC. 11. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, presidential decrees and
issuances, executive orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof inconsistent
with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 12. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
its publication in two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.
