

2,372 HFEP projects were completed

2.8M patients served by the Medical Assistance to Indigent Patients (MAIP) Program

66% currently on antiretroviral therapy (ART) among diagnosed people living with HIV (PLHIV)

1.38M of children aged 0-12 months were considered as **Fully Immunized**












DOH-wide Budget Trend 2018 GAA to 2024 NEP, Amount in Billion PhP


The **DOH-wide** 2024 NEP budget is <u>**3% lower**</u> than its 2023 GAA level.


CY 2024 NEP DOH-OSEC MAJOR COST DRIVERS




