S. NO 1092 AN ACT INSTITUTIONALIZING THE GRANT OF A TEACHING SUPPLIES ALLOWANCE FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

This bill provides teaching supplies allowance for public school teachers engage in actual classroom teaching. This will be in the amount of five thousand pesos (P 5,000) cash per teacher per school year, intended for the purchase of classroom supplies and materials such as chalks, erasers, and forms.

The bill also proposes that the secretary of education conduct a periodic review of the teaching supplies allowance and its prices, with a view to increasing its amount if necessary.
