AN ACT DECLARING MARCH 21 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NON-WORKING HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF CALAPAN, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO, IN COMMEMORATION OF ITS CHARTER ANNIVERSARY

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. March 21 of every year is hereby declared a special non-working holiday in the City of Calapan, Province of Oriental Mindoro, in commemoration of its Charter Anniversary.

SEC. 2. Repealing Clause. - Republic Act No. 8986 declaring March 21 as a working holiday in the City of Calapan is hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
